The *Power2Achieve™* programming has been designed to help schools enhance teaching and learning, shape an intentional culture of excellence and ethics, increase academic achievement, improve student retention, enhance college and workforce preparation, and reduce disciplinary problems.

Power2Achieve™ resources support schools engaged in RTI, PBS (PBIS), development of 21st century skills, building safe and supportive school climate, social emotional learning, and other educational ini-

tiatives.

Research, development, and field-testing of P2A programming and *Culture of Excellence & Ethics Assessment™* surveys was conducted by IEE in 2008-2011 in partnership with multiple organizations, including Center for the 4th & 5th Rs at SUNY Cortland, ICD at Drake University, Kansas State Department of Education, and over 50 schools across the country. Initial underwriting for P2A programming was provided by the John Templeton and Sanford N. McDonnell Foundations.
